

Suitable for both INDOOR and OUTDOOR operation, it accurately portrays a North American prototype Triple-Dome Tank Car based upon our research and on documented Official Blueprints referenced to standard Association of American Railroads (AAR) recommended practice.

The following instructions are intended to help you understand and operate all the features built into this product.

TRIPLE-DOME TANK CAR

The tank car is based upon a steel Freight Railcar of the typical of 1930's to 1970's era. Actual prototype examples of this type car, although modernized, may still be in daily use by North American Railroads and also on display at some Historical Railroads/Museums.

FEATURES:

Operating AAR-design knuckle couplers.
Detailed freight car trucks/wheelsets with individual springs.
Realistic Detailing and Authentic Painting.
Moveable Hatch Cover on Domes.
BRASS grab-railings.
Full Underframe, including Air Brake System components.
Set of 4 (6 Designs) Full Color Placards.

TRUCK BEARINGS

The truck sideframes are molded of a thermal plastic which reproduces all details and, for durability, a special bearing has been permanently inserted in each journal box end. These bearings are designed to operate properly WITHOUT lubrication. However, you MAY lubricate, if desired, using either a dry lubricant of powered graphite or an oil-based paste lubricant (ART-29602) but ONLY in very small amounts. It is not necessary to disassemble freight railcar trucks to properly lubricate. Turn the freight railcar upside down and apply lubricant to axle ends at truck sideframe.

TRUCK SPRINGS

The trucks/wheelsets on this model are designed exactly like the trucks used on prototype railroads, and use springs for equalization to act as a shock absorber and cushion the ride.

COUPLERS

Loop-style couplers (ART 29101-69) are enclosed as a spare accessory. The operating knuckle couplers on all ARISTO-CRAFT TRAINS freight railcars are designed based upon the AAR-style knuckle used on all major North American Railroads.

NOTE: However, these knuckle couplers may not operate automatically when attempting to couple ARISTO-CRAFT TRAINS products to knuckle couplers used by other model railroad manufacturers. Couplers may have to be joined by manually coupling the knuckle on each car in a closed position then lifting one end coupler and inserting the closed knuckle onto the ARISTO-CRAFT TRAINS knuckle coupler.

This type knuckle coupler works equally well from either end of the freight railcar and can be uncoupled automatically by using an LGB+ designed uncoupling device. The couplers may also be operated manually by pressing upward on the small tab below each coupler assembly. The coupler can be pushed away to any side if you wish the railcar not to couple automatically when the railcars come together. However, DO NOT attempt to operate in train without the couplers properly alligned and fully coupled to opposite railcar/locomotive. Otherwise, railcar(s) may derail on curves or switch

Should you prefer to use the Loop-style coupler (ART 29101-69), this conversion can be made easily and quickly by unscrewing the single screw that holds the AAR knuckle coupler to the truck arm and attaching the Loopstyle coupler using the same screw. Both style couplers are attached to truck arm at a swivel base. When operating railcar, this enables coupler(s) to articulate when encountering sharp radius curves or switches. Couplers will center automatically while railcar is in motion. Manual centering is accomplished by exerting light pressure on knuckle. Knuckle/Loop at articulated joint and returning knuckle. Knuckle/Loop to center.

No assembly required, TRIPLE-DOME TANK CAR is ready-to-run. (except ART-41600K-KIT)

This warranty is VOID and does not apply to any product and/or parts and components which have been improperly installed by purchaser/owner, abused or damaged in any way through improper operation such as train derailment, modified, or repaired by unauthorized service centers and/or non-factory authorized technicians.

SERVICING

Should your ARISTO-CRAFT TRAINS product require warranty service, be sure to take the following steps to assure proper servicing:

- 1. Return product in ORIGINAL BOX, then pact this ORIGINAL BOX in proper shipping carton. If not possible to use original box, pack product carefully in cardboard box, FULLY INSURED and PREPAID. ARISTO-CRAFT TRAINS will not be responsible for any damage or loss incurred during shipping.
- 2. Include a brief but thorough explanation of the problem(s) and the servicing that may be required.
